PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

This beautiful Charleville landmark was purpose-built in 1887 to house Charleville's first national bank. It later served the community as a private boarding house. Then, in the 1970s the building was purchased by the Charleville and District Historical Society to house today's Museum. Explore the rooms of this magnificent old Queenslander, filled to the brim with historical photographs, memorabilia, artefacts and timeless treasures. Step outside and you'll discover a life-size replica Cobb & Co Coach, Rail Ambulance and Steam Engine.
