Cattle are purchased on the ground in Roma and taken throughout the state and as far south as Victoria. Every year, around 4000 visitors join a free guided tour of the facility for an incredible insight into life on the land. NEW for 2020 is a state-of-the-art interpretive centre telling the story of the cattle industry.


* Cattle auction viewing is on most Tuesdays & Thursdays (subject to seasonal conditions)
